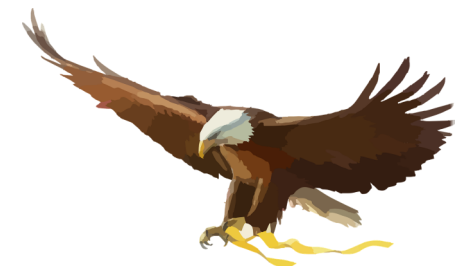
**Renewal**

Renewal is something that has become a regular fixture in our world today. I tend to think of renewing a subscription service like Netflix or say a driver’s license. It can be cumbersome and annoying to have to take time out of a usually busy schedule and find the needed information to renew things. However much of an inconvenience it may be, it is necessary and we all know that. So what about other types of renewal?

If our legal documents, entertainment, car warranties, and a multiplicity of other items need renewal, how much more do our souls need to be renewed? You might be thinking, “Ben, how would I do that?” Isaiah 40:30-31 say, “Even youths shall faint and be weary, and young men shall fall exhausted; but they who wait for the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles; they shall run and not be weary; they shall walk and not faint.”

The Lord knew and knows His people will grow weary. Do we need proper rest like sleep? Of course, it will help us physically but we also need to renew our inner strength. That renewal, renewal we WILL need, only comes from the Lord God Almighty. Listen then to the words of verses 28 and 29 from the same chapter, “Have you not known? Have you not heard?
