LEAN

There's a popular song many know with lyrics, "Lean on me / When you're not strong / And I'll be your friend / I'll help you carry on . . ." (Bill Withers, 1972) With the holidays and around this time in general, so many are hurting due to loved ones lost as well as many other struggles we encounter. When we are in need of comfort and help, who will we turn to?

Maybe it is our spouse, a close friend, a close relative, our parents, or professionals like counselors. Even when others pass, people often talk to them wondering what they might do or what kind of help they could offer. As kids, even the smallest of things may need a parent's comfort like a small scrape or a stuffed animal needing to be repaired. There is a children's Bible song with the lyrics of "Whose side are you leaning on? I'm leaning on the Lord's side."

While "Lean on Me" is a popular song, and many people can offer assistance and maybe a shoulder, there is no better place to turn to than the Lord. Recall Proverbs 3:5: "Trust in the Lord with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding . . ." The hymn "Leaning on the Everlasting Arms" has some of the words: "What a blessedness, what a peace is mine, Leaning on the everlasting arms. Leaning on Jesus, Leaning on Jesus."

As we start a new year I want us to think about two things: 1. Am I leaning on the Lord or my own (or others') understanding? 2. Do I truly buy in to the peace, blessedness, and protection that only comes from leaning on Jesus? "22 And it has often cast him into fire and into water, to destroy him. But if you can do anything, have compassion on us and help us." 23 And Jesus said to him, "If you can't! All things are possible for one who believes." 24 Immediately the father of the child cried out] and said, "I believe; help my unbelief!" (Mark 9:22-24)

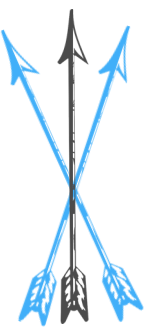
