Learning from Ice

While I have always been careful around ice, since slipping a few weeks ago it has been on my mind. Last week we received a good bit of snow and some ice. One concern of mine was whether or not we would need to lay down salt and take care of the parking lot. The last thing I want is for someone to get hurt in the parking lot! With ice maintenance on my mind, I figure there are some spiritual lessons we can draw.

1. Ice is slick even when you can’t see it.

I’ve heard all kinds of stories where people have been in accidents because of this very thing. I am reminded of the sign “bridge freezes before road” that warns drivers during cold times to be careful. Spiritually we must be prepared like the driver on the bridge should. Sin can trip us up even when we do not see it coming. In fact, I would say quite often we feel blindsided. Our enemy is eager to see us stumble. Be sober and vigilant!

2. Ice can be fun but can also be dangerous

From a young age I wanted to learn how to play hockey but my mother was keen on me keeping my teeth. Nonetheless there are countless people who spend a lot of time on ice competing, fishing, and just having fun. While ice can bring a lot of enjoyment it can cause heartbreak. Sin is much the same. Sure sin can be fun but it is very dangerous in this life and even more so in the next!

3. It’s not a slippery slope

Whether it is in a car, while you’re skating, or just walking out in the cold we can slip and fall. We may slide some on the ice but one way or another we will stop. People often talk about sin as a slippery slope and I understand why. You can’t play hokey pokey with sin and come out clean. The problem is thinking once you slide down there is no getting back up. We have the redemptive blood of Christ but we must repent and turn away not remaining in sin but striving towards that upward call in Christ Jesus.

The next time it gets icy remember these lessons for your physical and spiritual safety.
