That leaves me though thinking of how we can be level. Oftentimes we speak of people being (or not being) levelheaded. Yet, when it comes to figuring out if something is or is not level there are a few steps. The first and most obvious is that an item, say a clock, is not level. While one could move it around until it seems fine, we can know for certain whether or not it really is level.

That tool for us is not from a toolbox, nor is it some dusty, old book cobbled together by overzealous people. We have for ourselves God's Holy, inspired Word that we are able to have the utmost confidence in. When the honest person puts God's Word first it can only be a matter

of time before one is standing on solid, sound, and level ground. Remember not to forget your level at home, you never know when you'll need

it!


