LEVEL

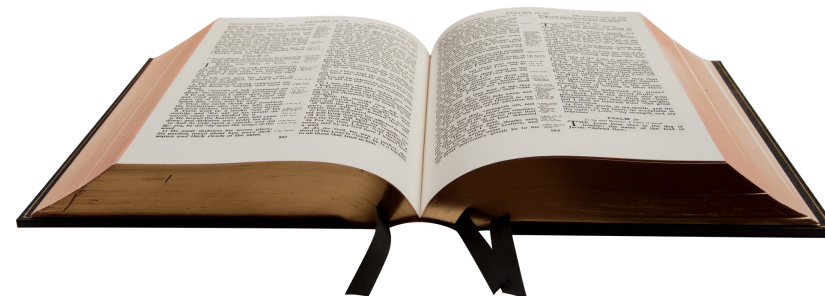

A few weeks back we got a new clock in the auditorium. The goal in that specific clock was to be easier to change the batteries and be able to be seen well. So far it seems that it meets both criteria but there was one additional area that became of note to many. The clock wasn't level. That's right, the contractors who installed apparently had some struggles getting it to sit properly. I hope you are relieved to find out it was jimmied and measured to indeed be level now.

That leaves me though thinking of how we can be level. Oftentimes we speak of people being (or not being) levelheaded. Yet, when it comes to figuring out if something is or is not level there are a few steps. The first and most obvious is that an item, say a clock, is not level. That can be observed with no training or tools. If something isn't sitting right it sticks out. While one could move it around until it seems fine, we can know for certain whether or not it really is level.

For that, we get out a tool or device to ensure the item in question is indeed level. The same steps should occur with the honest person. It could be their viewpoint on something or actions that have been done but the honest person realizes there is a problem with what is going on. How can we know that where we stand with our doctrine is truly level? Just like before, we get a tool to ensure it.

That tool for us is not from a toolbox, nor is it some dusty, old book cobbled together by overzealous people. We have for ourselves God's Holy, inspired Word that we are able to have the utmost confidence in. When the honest person puts God's Word first it can only be a matter of time before one is standing on solid, sound, and level ground. Remember not to forget your level at home, you never know when you'll need it!

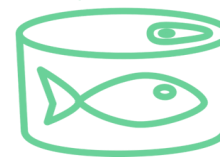
