## Giving Thanks

At first the idea of thanksgiving might be Native Americans and pilgrims having a feast. We may think of events and conditions surrounding that time which we remember so regularly. Often, it is a time of gathering with family and enjoying each other's company. Long before such a meal would take place, God's Word was teaching that thanksgiving is an important and regular part of the Christian faith.

In both the Corinthian letters, Colossians, Ephesians, Philippians, and the letters to the Thessalonians, we see Paul mention thanksgiving. Paul talks of having thanksgiving in prayer for what the Lord has done and for the faith many of the churches have been living. Many of the words in those sections are showing those faithful Christians appreciation for holding fast to the faith. Yet even before the various letters to the churches, thanksgiving was a biblical concept.

Nehemiah and other books mention songs of thanksgiving and praise. Others in the Old Testament tie thanksgiving into the sacrifices that are made like in 2 Chronicles as well as Leviticus. Given the history recorded in the Bible, it should be quite clear that such a holiday today is not that groundbreaking.

As we think of this holiday, do remember the historical significance of what has happened in this country, but all the while, do not forget how intertwined thanksgiving is to the Christian faith. From the smallest matters to the biggest, we have a lot to be thankful for. Verbalizing that thanks is one way to ensure we understand it, but in the same manner, our actions will speak to what we are truly thankful for. 2 Corinthians 4:15 says, "For it is all for your sake, so that as grace extends to more and more people it may increase thanksgiving, to the glory of God."

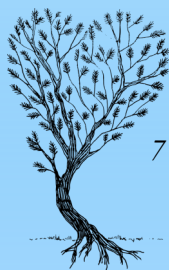
