## UNDERSTANDING PURPOSE

Whether it be in school studying the anatomy of the body, in business learning strategies for selling, or as a grandparent giving instruction to your grandchildren there is a discussion of purpose. It is pretty important for doctors to understand the purpose an organ, joint, bone, or other part of the body. Similarly, a salesperson benefits from understanding the purpose behind how they can convince people to buy their products. Grandparents often explain the purpose behind family traditions or inform the kids as to why what they are doing is not a good idea.

Purpose and the meaning behind what we do is very important to us as humans as well as servants of God. The Lord's Supper has purpose behind it as 1 Corinthians 11:26 says, "For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes."
