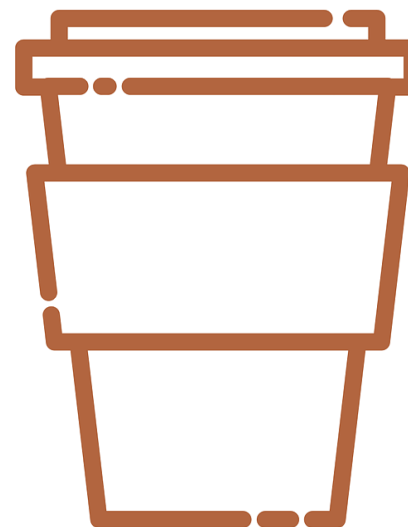

Need a Filter?

Whether it is a pot of coffee or doing other drinks like a cold brew, the filter is an important part of making the drink. The filter allows the liquid to pass through but keeps the grounds behind as many people do not want coffee grounds in their drinks. Filters are used across many areas as they are quite important for taking out impurities.



As a Christian we too can benefit from using a filter for our thoughts and actions. Now, it should be no surprise that we cannot simply go to the store and buy a “Christian life filter.” Instead we must look to God’s Word for what can be helpful for us to filter out the impurities that we deal with. Philippians 4:8 says, “Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is worthy of respect, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is commendable, if something is excellent or praiseworthy, think about these things.”

Consider this your Philippians filter. Paul gives the Philippians and us as well criteria of what we ought to consider carefully. In each matter we can run our thoughts and actions through the filter. Is it true? Is this pure or worthy of respect? If it isn't, why would we want to be associated with it? While we may not all be coffee drinkers, we all need to use such a filter more. Take advantage of the filter we have available to us and catch those impurities just like with coffee. Throw them out and enjoy the cup that overflows.

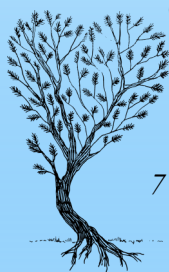
