I grew up enjoying many episodes of *Mr. Rogers’ Neighborhood*. His show was as informative as it was wholesome. He invited us to be a friend, learn, and go on some adventures. Maybe the classic children’s programming takes you back to a simpler time but I know for certain how we treat our neighbor will be a timeless matter for God’s people.

Paul in Romans 13:9-10 says, “For the commandments, “You shall not commit adultery, You shall not murder, You shall not steal, You shall not covet,” and any other commandment, are summed up in this word: “You shall love your neighbor as yourself.” Love does no wrong to a neighbor; therefore love is the fulfilling of the law.”

Every week I see reports of people checking cars for unlocked doors, shoplifting, and other robberies. Much of these incidents fall back to the commandments Paul mentions. It is one thing to be told not to steal or not to covet. The command goes deeper when it is tied to loving your neighbor as yourself. Too often we can be carried away focusing on the negatives of “I deserve that” or “so and so shouldn’t have such a nice item when I have such worn down things”

So, people steal, pilfer, and kill. Yet, we would always do well to consider reversing the positions. Asking ourselves, “How would I feel if this was done to me”? It certainly will take more time and more out of us to consider the other side of our thoughts and actions. Such acts should make us more humble, as it is not my neighbor’s fault that I might be struggling and he or she is not.

“Won’t you be my neighbor” is a phrase a great deal of us remember fondly. In many ways Mr. Rogers’ song desiring to make new friends can be likened to Our Creator’s desire for us to be reconciled to Him. The word neighbor originates from one who dwells near. In heaven it will always be a beautiful day, and the Lord is always wanting his children, men and women of all races to draw near to him. As we strive to faithfully follow the Lord Almighty, let us love our neighbors as ourselves and all draw near to Him. “So let’s make the most of this beautiful day”.

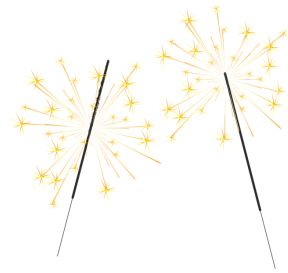
