

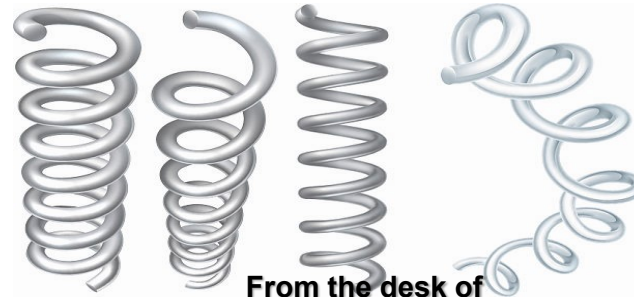

# Spring Time

For most people, if not all, when we say “It’s Spring time,” we are talking about the seasons changing. I know I am far from normal, but I always default to thinking about mechanical springs. For me it is not just the springs I think about but a math formula tied to them, so stay with me here.

$F = -kx$  “F” stands for the force that occurs. “k” is number tied to the type and material of the spring. “x” is the distance moved by the spring. So, why mention all of this? I’m glad you asked! We must first remember that God made and designed the phenomena in the world (Jer. 33:25). Thus, we can learn about our Creator from the world around us.

I urge you to think of yourself as a spring. Each of us is different, like springs we have specific traits tied to us. Often in physics, a spring is mounted or fixed on one end. This mount allows for the spring to stretch and compress only to return to its original position. Also like the spring you have a place to be fixed upon. You must choose whether you are fixed upon God or not.

“No one can serve two masters, for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon” (Matt. 6:24). Sometimes in life we are stretched thin, other times we feel crunched for time. It is up to us, knowing our unique traits, to live a life that allows us for a proper return to God through out all of it.

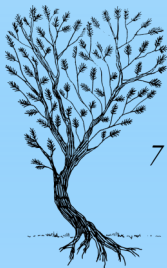
