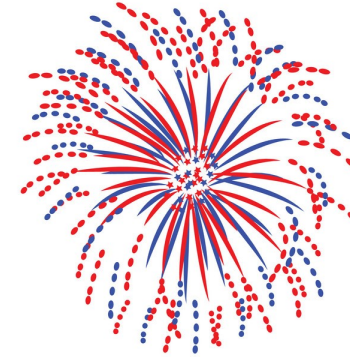

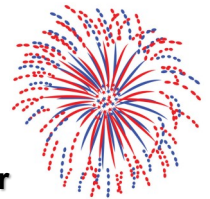

From the desk of **Ben Rominske**, minister

This week we celebrate the 4th of July, which commemorates the passage of the Declaration of Independence. The Declaration and the Revolutionary War are often thought of during this time. We celebrate our freedom from British rule and the hope we had for the future of this nature. For decades it has been a holiday surrounded by fun times and fond memories. Christians from every nation also celebrate our freedom and do so more often than once a year.

Romans 6:5-8 says, "5 For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we shall certainly be united with him in a resurrection like his. 6 We know that our old self was crucified with him in order that the body of sin might be brought to nothing, so that we would no longer be enslaved to sin. 7 For one who has died has been set free from sin."

Such a time of remembrance and celebration can be seen in numerous different ways. When we assemble on the first day of the week and partake of the Lord's Supper we remember His sacrifice and thus our freedom because of it. Another way we can be reminded of that freedom is in what Paul describes there in Romans with baptism and our forgiveness of sins.

Finally, we can celebrate our freedom in Christ from sin with how we act and live. In Christ there is no condemnation. He conquered sin and death. What is there then to fear? For those of us who have followed God's Word and responded to the Gospel call, we ought to live like we have freedom!!
